Training will run from January 2016 to November 2016 and some of the main courses will include Digital Literacy, Basic Computer Training, Social Media and Microsoft Office Suite.

The JLS commissioned Needs Assessment Survey (August 2014) revealed that 75% of library users expressed an interest in basic computer skills training.
